Next Sunday is World Mission Sunday

On October 10, 2018, Pope Francis said, "Mission means 'to be sent' and every Christian is a missionary." He went on to say that we proclaim the Good News first and foremost by how we live our lives. Our caring and loving behaviors will move people to embrace the Gospel. Making sacrifices for others is the best way to proclaim the Gospel for all the world to see.

The Pope said that by virtue of Baptism all Christians have received *the mission to bring the Gospel to everyone*. Speaking to the young people gathered in Rome for the Youth Synod, he said that they are part of that great stream of witnesses to the Joy of the Gospel.

The heart of the Church's mission is to radiate the Joy of the Gospel. The spread of the faith "by attraction", he said, calls for hearts that are open and expanded by love. Love in itself will be a proclamation that will reach to the ends of the earth. The funds that are collected in the second collection next Saturday and Sunday will help churches, schools and seminaries in mission territories around the world.
